



Field Experience monitoring Gaseous Mercury compounds continuously for both Emissions and Process control

In Germany and in other European countries the regulation for Mercury emissions from Coal plants as well as Cement and Waste incineration plants is becoming stricter. With the new BREF (Best Available Reference Technique) issued by the EU for Large Combustion Plants, many of the existing plants are using continuous Hg monitoring to actively control their removal systems and for final emission control. This presentation will focus on some key installations which show the benefits and challenges of continuous mercury emissions in industrial plants and provide information on the experience gained in the recent years.
